

AN ORDINANCE

BY: VICE MAYOR BYINGTON NO. 4806

TO AMEND SECTION I, 2015 ORIGINAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE NO. 4799, TO PROVIDE FOR THE APPROPRIATION OF:

AN ADDITIONAL AMOUNT OF \$230,000 TO BE EXPENDED FROM THE GENERAL EQUIPMENT REPLACEMENT FUND FOR THE PURCHASE OF 800 MHZ PUBLIC SAFETY RADIO EQUIPMENT.

FOR THE CITY OF OAKWOOD, STATE OF OHIO, DURING THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2015.

WHEREAS, the city's capital improvement schedule includes the replacement and upgrading of public service radio equipment in 2015 and in 2016, as required for compatibility and interoperability with the countywide 800 MHZ/MARCS radio system; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager and Director of Public Safety have determined that preferential pricing can be obtained if the total expenditure is made in 2015, thereby reducing the overall project cost of this mandatory project by about \$29,000, lessening the financial impact to the city; and

WHEREAS, in order to make funds available in 2015 for completing the public safety radio upgrade, the City Manager has recommended an amendment to the appropriation ordinance passed by Council on December 8, 2014;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OAKWOOD, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION I.

To provide for the current expenses and other expenditures of the said city of Oakwood during the period commencing January 1, 2015 and ending December 31, 2015, the following revised sums shall be and they are hereby set aside and appropriated as follows, with added material in **bold** type and deleted material in ~~strike-through~~ type:

SECTION II.

The additional \$230,000 appropriation shall be for the purchase and acquisition of 800 MHz radios, radio dispatch equipment and related items that will allow for the city to dispatch and monitor public safety forces and communicate on the countywide 800 MHZ/MARCS radio system.

SECTION III.

The Director of Finance is hereby authorized to draw warrants for payments from any of the foregoing appropriations upon receiving proper certificates and vouchers therefore, approved by this ordinance of Council to make the expenditures; provided that no warrants shall be drawn or paid for salaries or wages except to persons employed by authority of and in accordance with law or ordinance.

SECTION IV.

This ordinance, as an appropriation to meet current expenses of the City, takes effect immediately upon its passage as provided by Section 3.04 of the City Charter.
