Pursuant to the call of the President, the Board met in special session at 6:00 P. M. at the residence of C. L. Shroyer, all members and the clerk being present.

The object of the meeting being to consider the matter of incorporation of Village of Oakwood.

The adoption of the following resolution was moved by C. H. Barton, seconded by J. H. Kohl:

Whereas, at our regular meeting held June 29, the Board in the matter of incorporation of the Village of Oakwood, adopted a resolution incorporating the territory described in the petition and calling the election as prayed for to be held on the 15th day of July-

And, Whereas, It appears that such election should have been called to be held within 15 days of the date the order was made, and that our calling it on the 16th day will render further proceedings defective; therefore,

Resolved, That our said former resolution and order of June 29 be and is hereby rescinded and set aside.

It is further ordered and declared that such village has been incorporated by the name of the "Village of Oakwood, State of Ohio," and a certified transcript of the journal entries of all the proceedings of this board in this matter, together with the original petition and plat, shall be delivered to the recorder of said county of Montgomery.
