

A RESOLUTION

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT A REVISED APPLICATION FOR FEDERAL FAST ACT FUNDS THROUGH THE MIAMI VALLEY REGIONAL PLANNING COMMISSION.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 1781, adopted by Council on October 7, 2013, the Director of Public Works submitted an application to the Miami Valley Regional Planning Commission ("MVRPC") for federal MAP-21 funding consideration in the SFY2018-2019 Transportation Improvement Program for the following project:

Shroyer Road Improvement Project (Project No. 02-124i) – Improvements from East Stroop Road in the city of Kettering to the North Corporate Line of the city of Oakwood (Joint application with the city of Kettering);

and

WHEREAS, said application requested that the following exemptions to MVRPC's Regional Complete Streets Policy be granted:

Shroyer Road Improvement Project (Project No. 02-124i): Exemption No. 4 – The project consists of maintenance, repair or resurfacing of an existing cross-section only;

and

WHEREAS, the Shroyer Road Improvement Project was accepted by MVRPC and was assigned an Ohio Department of Transportation ("ODOT") PID No. 97897; and

WHEREAS, Council has approved an amendment through Resolution No. 1817 adopted by Council on April 4, 2016 to the project involving implementation of a *Road Diet* concept that would provide for the construction of center medians and restriping along Shroyer Road from the city's South Corporate Line to its North Corporate Line, thereby reconfiguring the typical cross-section of Shroyer Road in the city of Oakwood from four lanes to three, with single through lanes in each direction, protected left turn lanes, bicycle lanes in both directions, and two mid-block crosswalks; and

WHEREAS, Council wishes to authorize the City Manager to submit a revised scope to MVRPC reflecting the foregoing amendment to the project and seeking additional funding at the same federal match rate, (60/40) as the original application; and

WHEREAS, the City will commit to a timely project development schedule and will commit the necessary resources to support the local cost portion of this project, subject to appropriate cost-allocation with the city of Kettering to be agreed upon in undertaking this joint project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OAKWOOD, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION I.

The City Manager or his designee is authorized to submit a revised application through the MVRPC for federal FAST Act funding as set forth above, and to do so jointly with the city of Kettering, and to prepare and submit any related documentation that may be necessary or desirable to further said application.

SECTION II.

To the extent that an agreement of cooperation with the city of Kettering may be necessary or desirable to further the intent of this Resolution, the City Manager is authorized to enter into the same on terms that are expedient and beneficial to the city of Oakwood.

SECTION III.

If any outside funding has already been applied for and/or secured, or may be applied for after adoption of this Resolution, relating to the local cost portion of this project, the City Manager is authorized to apply the same to the amended project as fully as it would have been applied to the

original project, to the extent permitted by law, and to prepare and submit any documentation that may be necessary or desirable to amend applications therefor accordingly.

SECTION IV.


This Resolution shall be and remain in force from and after the date of its adoption.


