

A RESOLUTION

ESTABLISHING THE BEAUTIFICATION COMMITTEE FOR
THE CITY OF OAKWOOD AND AUTHORIZING THE
APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS TO SAID COMMITTEE.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OAKWOOD, OHIO:

SECTION 1.

That in order to preserve the sylvan setting of the City of Oakwood, to encourage all Oakwood residents and property owners in the landscaping of their properties, to emphasize the desirability of maintaining and improving the planted and landscaped areas of the City, to promote and encourage the care and maintenance of the entire area of Oakwood so as to preserve and to continue this suburban community as a particularly desirable place to live, to emphasize the value to all Oakwood residents and property owners of a continuing campaign to maintain all property in this City in excellent condition and state of repair, and to promote the general beautification of this suburb, the Beautification Committee of the City of Oakwood is hereby established.

SECTION 2.

That said Committee shall consist of not less than five (5) members, who shall serve for a term of three (3) years or until their successors are appointed, whichever first occurs. That the terms of those persons appointed to form the first such Beautification Committee shall be as follows, however, in order to provide continuity in future years: One-half (1/2) of the members of the first said Committee shall be appointed for one and one-half years. The remaining members shall be appointed for a term of three years. At the expiration of the initial term of each member, his or her successor shall be appointed to serve a full term of three years. That all members of said Committee shall be appointed by this Council through a motion passed by a majority of a quorum of the Council. That the Committee shall have the power to appoint a technical advisory staff consisting of persons who, although not members of said Committee, have special knowledge and information which may be of assistance to the Committee in accomplishing its goals. That all members of said Committee and of said technical advisory staff shall serve without compensation and shall be selected on the basis of the special skills, talents, energy and knowledge which they have to contribute toward the goals and purposes of said committee.

TO APPOINT AS AN EX-OFFICIO MEMBER OF THE OAKWOOD BEAUTIFICATION COMMITTEE THE CHAIRMAN OF THE OAKWOOD YOUTH BEAUTIFICATION COMMITTEE, AND ALSO TO APPOINT TWO ALTERNATE MEMBERS OF THE OAKWOOD BEAUTIFICATION COMMITTEE FROM THE OAKWOOD YOUTH BEAUTIFICATION COMMITTEE.

WHEREAS, it is deemed desirable that the Oakwood Beautification Committee have representation on that body from the Oakwood Youth Beautification Committee, and it has been suggested that the Chairman of the Oakwood Youth Beautification Committee serve as an Ex-Officio Member of the Oakwood Beautification Committee and it has been further suggested that said Chairman should have certain alternates from the Oakwood Youth Beautification Committee who may attend meetings of the Oakwood Beautification Committee with the Chairman and may act for him in his absence;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OAKWOOD, OHIO:

THAT, the Chairman of the Oakwood Youth Beautification Committee is hereby named as an Ex-Officio Member of the Oakwood Beautification Committee; and that Chris Yerkes, as such Chairman, is hereby constituted an Ex-Officio Member of the Oakwood Beautification Committee during the time he serves as such Chairman.

THAT, two alternate members of the Oakwood Beautification Committee are hereby appointed from the Oakwood Youth Beautification Committee, to attend meetings of the Oakwood Beautification Committee together with the aforesaid Chairman, and to act for said Chairman in his absence; Kathy Herbert and Curt Schaeffer of the Oakwood Youth Beautification Committee are hereby named and designated as such alternates.

AN ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING ADDITIONAL DUTIES FOR THE ENVIRONMENTAL COMMITTEE AND THE HORTICULTURIST OF THE CITY OF OAKWOOD.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OAKWOOD, OHIO:

SECTION I.

In addition to all other duties assigned to the Environmental Committee, we hereby assign the additional duties of oversight to the City Horticulturist in regard to the maintenance of Street and Park Trees.

SECTION II.

It shall be the responsibility of the Environmental Committee to study, investigate, counsel, develop and annually update a written plan of recommendation for the planning, care, preservation, pruning, replanting, removal or disposition of trees and shrubs in the parks and along the street and other public areas of the City of Oakwood. Such recommendations shall be made to the City Council at least once each calendar year of more frequently as either the Committee or the City Council may deem desirable. Upon the acceptance of such recommendations they shall be considered to be the operating rules for this community as to street and park trees.


SECTION III.

SECTION IV.


This Ordinance shall take effect from and after this date permitted by Law.
