

AN ORDINANCE

BY: VICE MAYOR BYINGTON NO. 4826

TO AMEND SECTION I, 2016 ORIGINAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE NO. 4816, AND SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE NO. 4823 TO PROVIDE FOR THE APPROPRIATION OF:

1. AN ADDITIONAL AMOUNT OF \$475,000 TO BE EXPENDED FROM THE SPECIAL PROJECTS FUND FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A PARKING LOT AT OLD RIVER SPORTS COMPLEX.
2. AN AMOUNT OF \$350,000 TO BE TRANSFERRED FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO THE SPECIAL PROJECTS FUND.

FOR THE CITY OF OAKWOOD, STATE OF OHIO, DURING THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2016.

WHEREAS, on September 21, 2015, Council adopted Resolution No. 1806 to support the development of a multi-purpose artificial turf field facility and track at the Old River Sports Complex (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 1806, the City Manager signed the Old River Athletic Facility Agreement (the "Agreement") with the Oakwood City School District (the "School District"), providing a framework for the Project to proceed as a joint effort by the City and the School District, with private funding to be raised by the Oakwood Athletic Boosters, Inc. (the "Boosters"); and

WHEREAS, on April 4, 2016, Council adopted Resolution No. 1816 to approve the proposed design for the Project, which the School District subsequently put out for public bidding; and

WHEREAS, on July 5, 2016, Council adopted Resolution No. 1821 addressing the split in cost for construction of the 346 parking spaces required for the Old River Sports Complex, which includes the existing grass playing fields and the multi-purpose artificial turf field and track facility; and

WHEREAS, in order to make funds available in 2016 for completing the construction of a portion of the parking lot as described in Resolution No. 1821, the City Manager has recommended an amendment to the appropriation ordinance passed by Council on December 7, 2015;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OAKWOOD, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION I.

To provide for the current expenses and other expenditures of the said city of Oakwood during the period commencing January 1, 2016 and ending December 31, 2016, the following revised sums shall be and they are hereby set aside and appropriated as follows, with added material in bold type and deleted material in strike-through type:

250 Special Projects Fund	\$-0-	\$475,000
101 General Fund	\$10,329,641	\$10,679,641

SECTION II.

The additional \$475,000 appropriation from the Special Projects Fund shall be for the construction of a parking lot at Old River Sports Complex.

SECTION III.

The Director of Finance is hereby authorized to draw warrants for payments from any of the foregoing appropriations upon receiving proper certificates and vouchers therefore, approved by this ordinance of Council to make the expenditures; provided that no warrants shall be drawn or paid for salaries or wages except to persons employed by authority of and in accordance with law or ordinance.

SECTION IV.


This ordinance, as an appropriation to meet current expenses of the City, takes effect immediately upon its passage as provided by Section 3.04 of the City Charter.


