RESOLUTION

BY MR. CASTLEMAN NO 1655

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT WITH THE OHIO PATROLMEN'S BENEVOLENT ASSOCIATION REPRESENTING THE DISPATCHER/RECORDS CLERK, AND PUBLIC SAFETY DISPATCHERS.

A copy of the resolution, having been placed on the desks of each member of council prior to introduction, was read by title. Mr. Klopsch noted that the new contract provides pay increases of 3.5%, 4.0% and 4.0% for 2007, 2008 and 2009 respectively.
