The Mayor, Mr. William Duncan, presided, and the Acting Clerk of Council, Mr. Norbert Klopsch, recorded.

Mayor Duncan asked for a motion to dispense with approving the previous meeting minutes until the November 7 meeting. Motion by Mrs. Hilton; second by Mr. Castleman. Upon a viva voce vote, motion passed.

RESOLUTION

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE FOUR (4) COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENTS INCLUDING THE OAKWOOD CHAPTER OF THE OHIO COUNCIL 8, DAYTON PUBLIC SERVICE UNION, LOCAL 101, AMERICAN FEDERATION OF STATE, COUNTY, AND MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES, REPRESENTING OAKWOOD PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT EMPLOYEES; THE F.O.P. OAKWOOD LODGE NO. 107, REPRESENTING OAKWOOD PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICERS; THE OHIO PATROLMEN'S BENEVOLENT ASSOCIATION REPRESENTING OAKWOOD PUBLIC SAFETY LIEUTENANTS, AND THE OHIO PATROLMEN'S BENEVOLENT ASSOCIATION REPRESENTING DISPATCHERS AND DISPATCHER/RECORDS CLERK.

A copy of the resolution, having been placed on the desks of each member of council prior to introduction, was read in its entirety.

Thereupon, it was moved by Mr. Castleman and seconded by Mrs. Hilton that the resolution be passed.

Mr. Klopsch explained that the new contracts call for the following pay increases:

- 2% in 2012 for all four bargaining group.
- 1 ½% in 2013 for the lieutenants, safety officers and dispatchers, and 0% in 2013 for the public works employees.
- 0% in 2014 for the lieutenants, safety officers and dispatchers.

Upon call of the roll on the question of the motion, the following vote was recorded:

There being five (5) yea votes and no (0) nay votes thereon, said resolution was declared duly passed and it was so ordered.

Mayor Duncan commended staff for successfully negotiating new contracts. Vice Mayor Byington echoed the commendation.
