

**MINUTES  
OAKWOOD CITY COUNCIL WORK SESSION  
DECEMBER 10, 2012**

The council of the city of Oakwood, Ohio, met in a work session on Monday, December 10, 2012 in the conference room of the Oakwood Municipal Building, 30 Park Avenue. The Mayor of the city, William Duncan, presided. Council members in attendance were Mayor William Duncan, Vice Mayor Steven Byington, Stanley Castleman, Rob Stephens and Anne Hilton; Staff in attendance were City Manager Norbert Klopsch and City Attorney Rob Jacques.

Mayor Duncan called the work session to order at 7 p.m. and led a discussion on the following agenda items.

- STATUS REPORTS: There are no status reports scheduled for the formal meeting this evening.
- VISITORS: There are no visitors registered to speak at the formal meeting this evening.
- LEGISLATION: Council discussed the following legislation scheduled for action at the formal meeting this evening.
  - Resolution Opposing HB 601, Mayor Duncan
  - Ordinance to Approve 2013 Budget, Mr. Castleman. Mr. Klopsch noted that Finance Director Cindy Stafford would make a PowerPoint presentation about the 2013 budget and that it includes about \$500,000 less expenditure than the 2012 budget. Mayor Duncan commented that the 2013 budget reflects about \$1.5 million more expenses than receipts, highlighting that this will need to be addressed through new tax revenue in 2014.
  - Resolution Requesting Authorization to Establish Stormwater Capital Improvement Enterprise Fund, Mr. Castleman. Mr. Klopsch explained that the stormwater operating fund is already established.
  - Ordinance Amending Refuse Collection Rates, Mr. Castleman
  - Ordinance Approving Schedule of Fees in Civil, Criminal or Traffic Action or Proceeding, Mrs. Hilton. Mr. Jacques commented that these fees pay for the costs of safety department officers involved in performing certain services relating to civil, criminal and traffic cases. They will bring in a small amount of new revenue. Most of the new revenue budgeted from the court in 2013 will be generated if the judge increases criminal and traffic court costs and filing fees.
  - Resolution Approving Canopy Modifications at Beth Abraham Synagogue, Mr. Castleman

There being no other business, Mayor Duncan adjourned the work session at 7:25 p.m.
