

MARCH 3, 2014 COUNCIL MEETING

City Council met in public session on March 3, 2014. Here are the highlights.

STATUS REPORTS

- New Public Safety Officer – Mayor Bill Duncan and Chief Alex Bebris administered the Oath of Office and introduced new officer Jeff Yount, Jr.
- Mayor Bill Duncan proclaimed April as “Fair Housing Month”.

Minutes of the February 3, 2014 regular and work sessions of council and February 24, 2014 work session were approved.

LEGISLATION

Mayor Bill Duncan asked for citizen comments regarding the Income Tax Credit Limit Ordinance. Eighteen Oakwood citizens came before Council providing comments and recommendations.

By a 2-2 vote with Councilmember Stanley Castleman excused absent, Oakwood City Council denied the Ordinance amending Section 148.15, “Credit for Tax Paid to Another Municipality”.

Oakwood City Council approved the following legislation:

- Ordinance regarding Residential Building Code Enforcement.
- Resolution authorizing Francine’s Garden Endowment Fund.

COUNCIL COMMENTS

- Councilmember Anne Hilton thanked the Public Works Department for clearing the snow.
- Vice Mayor Steve Byington thanked and commended the League of Women Voters for bringing in speakers to help local governments determine how to make things better. He encouraged everyone to visit the Air Force Museum at Wright Patterson to view the Space Shuttle Exhibit.
- Mayor Bill Duncan read a letter to City Manager Norbert Klopsch from a citizen who experienced a sewer backup commending city personnel.
