

MINUTES
OAKWOOD CITY COUNCIL WORK SESSION
AUGUST 10, 2015

The Council of the city of Oakwood, Ohio, met in a work session on Monday, August 10, 2015 in the conference room of the Oakwood Municipal Building, 30 Park Avenue. The Mayor of the city, William Duncan, presided. Council members in attendance were Mayor William Duncan, Vice Mayor Steve Byington, Councilmember Rob Stephens and Councilmember Chris Epley. Councilmember Anne Hilton was excused absent. Staff in attendance were City Manager Norbert Klopsch and City Attorney Rob Jacques.

Mayor Duncan called the pre-council work session to order at 6:30 p.m. and began the meeting by reviewing the agenda for the formal meeting this evening.

- STATUS REPORTS: Mayor Duncan noted the following four items to be addressed during status reports at the formal meeting this evening:
 - Auditor of State Award.
 - Proclamation recognizing September as "Prostate Cancer Awareness Month".
 - Citizen Committee Appointment.
 - PSO Swear-In.

- LEGISLATION – Council discussed the following five items scheduled for the formal meeting this evening:
 - Ordinance to amend Section 303.08, *Impounding of Vehicles; Redemption*, of the Traffic Code.
 - Ordinance to repeal Chapter 1331, *Unreasonable Noises in Construction*, of the Oakwood Building Code and enact new Section 509.13, of the Oakwood General Offenses Code.
 - Ordinance to amend Section 101.02, *General Definitions*, of the Administrative Code.
 - Resolution to authorize participation in the Montgomery County Regional Radio Council.
 - Ordinance to create Deputy Clerk of Courts classification.

At 7 p.m., Mayor Duncan moved that Council go to executive session for labor negotiations, conference with attorney, and property matters; second by Mr. Epley. Upon viva voce vote, motion passed.

At 7:24 p.m., Mayor Duncan concluded the executive session at which time Council moved to the formal meeting.
