

**MINUTES**  
**OAKWOOD CITY COUNCIL WORK SESSION**  
**JANUARY 4, 2016**

The Council of the city of Oakwood, Ohio, met in a work session on Monday, January 4, 2016 at the Foell Public Works Center, 210 Shafor Boulevard. The Mayor of the city, William Duncan, presided. Council members in attendance were Mayor William Duncan, Vice Mayor Steve Byington, Councilmember Rob Stephens, Councilmember Anne Hilton and Councilmember Chris Epley. Staff in attendance were City Manager Norbert Klopsch and City Attorney Rob Jacques.

Mayor Duncan called the work session to order at 4:30 p.m. Mr. Klopsch explained that the purpose of the work session was to discuss a potential proposal from Verizon to install a cell phone tower at the Foell Public Works Center. Mr. Klopsch showed Council two possible locations for the tower. In addition to the tower, Verizon would need to construct a brick building to house some cell tower equipment. Mr. Klopsch discussed the application process that would require public hearings before the Planning Commission and City Council. The Planning Commission would make a recommendation on the application. City Council would render a decision on the matter.

At 4:50 p.m., Mayor Duncan adjourned the work session.
