

RESOLUTION

BY MR. MCGINNIS NO. 1238

TO DEFINE THE DUTIES OF THE BUDGET REVIEW COMMITTEE AND TO PROVIDE FOR APPOINTMENT BY CITY COUNCIL OF THE CHAIRMAN AND VICE-CHAIRMAN OF THAT COMMITTEE.

WHEREAS, the Budget Review Committee of this City has existed for a number of years and many citizens have contributed valuable public services by participating in the work of that Committee; and

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of those persons presently serving on the City Council that the powers and duties of the Budget Review Committee were never set forth in the form of a charge by the Council to accomplish certain tasks;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OAKWOOD, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION I.

The Budget Review Committee is hereby charged with the following:

The purpose of the Budget Review Committee is to assist City Council in establishing and promoting community goals through the budgetary process. This purpose includes:

- (1) Review and evaluation of five year programs and its relationship to the annual budget;
- (2) Review of existing programs as reflected in the budget in light of operation and results;
- (3) Review of proposed new directions as reflected in budget or other proposals and in the context of budgetary requirements, keeping in perspective the overall budget and budget priorities, and results to be achieved; and
- (4) Marketing to the community the recommended budget, tax increases or renewals, and/or other financial proposals.

SECTION II.

The Chairman and the Vice-Chairman of the Budget Review Committee shall be appointed by Council for a two year period. Each shall serve at the pleasure of Council and shall be subject to replacement at such time as Council may appoint a successor.

SECTION III.

This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage.

TO PROVIDE FOR REPRESENTATION ON THE BUDGET REVIEW COMMITTEE BY PERSONS FROM EACH VOTING PRECINCT.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OAKWOOD, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION I.

It is the desire of Council to have as members of the Budget Review Committee at least two representatives from each voting precinct. In making appointments to that committee, the Council shall keep this goal in mind.

SECTION II.

It is recognized that vacancies will occur on this committee. During the time required to identify and appoint suitable replacements who are willing to serve, representation from any particular precinct may be less than two.


SECTION III.

By oral motions recorded in the minutes of its meetings, the Council may expand the membership of the Budget Review Committee in any manner it deems appropriate.


SECTION IV.



RESOLUTION

BY MR. MCGINNIS NO 1333

TO REAFFIRM ESTABLISHMENT OF THE BUDGET REVIEW COMMITTEE SO AS TO CLARIFY ITS MEMBERSHIP AND PURPOSES.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OAKWOOD, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION I.

The establishment of the Budget Review Committee is hereby reaffirmed, with its responsibilities and membership to be as set forth in subsequent sections of this Resolution.


SECTION II.

The purposes and duties of the committee shall be to consider the financial needs of the City, the revenues available to the City and to counsel with the government of this City regarding those matters. In addition, the responsibilities of the committee shall include communicating to the government of this City the viewpoint of Oakwood residents as to the extent of services they desire, bearing in mind the cost of providing those services.


SECTION III.

The members of the committee shall be appointed by the City Council, with there to be two members from each voting precinct plus such additional members as the Council may determine. Each member shall serve for a term of four years. All members must be residents of the City. Council shall designate the chairperson and vice-chairperson of the committee.


