

RESOLUTION

BY MAYOR COOK NO 1599

TO ESTABLISH THE MLK BREAKFAST COMMITTEE.

WHEREAS, in January, 2004, the City of Oakwood joined the City of Kettering in conducting the Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Breakfast event to commemorate the life of Dr. King; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that the City of Oakwood should participate with the City of Kettering as a co-sponsor of this event each year; and

WHEREAS, the City's Comprehensive Plan adopted on June 14, 2004 includes as a new objective to "implement outreach programs that will make all new residents, particularly among racial and ethnic minorities, feel welcome and at home within the Oakwood community"; and

WHEREAS, co-sponsoring the MLK Breakfast event is recognized as one step the city can take to address this new objective; and

WHEREAS, City Council recognizes that there are other ways in which to address this objective and that it will be important to engage the community in this endeavor.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OAKWOOD, OHIO, THAT:

SECTION I.

The MLK Breakfast Committee is hereby established as an ongoing committee of city council. The committee shall consists of a minimum of seven members who shall serve four year terms. City Council shall select two members to serve as chair and vice chair respectively.

SECTION II.

The committee shall meet as needed, but a minimum of twice per year.


SECTION III.

The committee's primary mission is to plan and oversee Oakwood's role in the annual Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Breakfast event. Additionally, the committee shall work towards identifying ways in which the city can address the new outreach objective included in the 2004 Comprehensive Plan and stated above.


SECTION IV.

This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.


