

MINUTES
OAKWOOD CITY COUNCIL WORK SESSION
JUNE 11, 2012

The council of the city of Oakwood, Ohio, met in a work session on Monday, June 11, 2012 at 6:56 p.m. in the conference room of the Oakwood Municipal Building, 30 Park Avenue. The Mayor of the city, William Duncan, presided. Council members in attendance were Mayor William Duncan, Vice Mayor Steven Byington and Anne Hilton; Staff in attendance was Assistant City Manager Jay Weiskircher, Finance Director Cindy Stafford and City Attorney Rob Jacques. Excused absent were: Council members Stanley Castleman and Rob Stephens and City Manager Norbert Klopsch.

Motion by Mr. Byington, second by Mrs. Hilton to adjourn into executive session to discuss personnel matters.

At 7:21 p.m., motion by Mr. Byington, second by Mrs. Hilton to adjourn from executive session.

- **STATUS REPORTS.** Mayor Duncan noted he will be reading the Proclamation recognizing the Oakwood Club's 50th anniversary. Mayor Duncan commented that he and former Mayor Judy Cook attended last week's installment of the new female four star General at WPAFB. He also noted that Oakwood is hosting this week's Mayors & Managers Meeting at C'est Tout and the primary discussion topic is development of legislation on income tax uniformity.

 - Neighborhood Meetings. Vice Mayor Byington noted that he, Jay and Carol will be attending the scheduled neighborhood meeting on Tuesday, June 12 at the residence of Kyle Maschino. Mr. Weiskircher indicated he will call Al Leland on Tuesday to check on the status of next Monday night's scheduled meeting. It was also mentioned that the neighborhood meeting originally scheduled for June 19 has been cancelled at the request of the hosting resident due to a family illness.
 - **PLANNING & ZONING, MR. BYINGTON**
 - Pointe Oakwood. Mr. Weiskircher asked whether the 3-D drawing of the proposed Oakwood condos was helpful? Mayor Duncan and Vice Mayor Byington indicated they had hoped to see a more detailed view of the corner than what has been developed at this point. Mr. Weiskircher indicated he would speak to Mr. Reeder about enhancing the rendering and dropping in trees and other landscaping details. He added that OIG intends to present the plan details on the condos at the July 11 Planning Commission meeting.
