

**MINUTES  
JOINT MEETING  
OAKWOOD CITY COUNCIL/OAKWOOD SCHOOL BOARD/WRIGHT LIBRARY BOARD  
FEBRUARY 23, 2015**

Oakwood City Council met in a joint meeting with the Oakwood School Board and Wright Memorial Public Library Board at 5 p.m. on Monday, February 23, 2015. The meeting took place in the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor training room at the Oakwood city building, 30 Park Avenue. Attending on behalf of the city of Oakwood were Mayor William Duncan, Vice Mayor Steve Byington, Councilmember Rob Stephens, Councilmember Anne Hilton and Councilmember Chris Epley. Also attending were City Manager Norbert Klopsch and City Attorney Robert Jacques.

Mayor Duncan called the meeting to order at 5 p.m. and invited Oakwood Treasurer/Business Manager Kevin Philo to open the school board meeting. Thereafter, Mayor Duncan asked all persons attending the meeting to give a self-introduction. Following introductions, Mayor Duncan invited Wright Library representatives to provide an overview of projects and issues. Wright Library Director Travis Bautz provided the update. Thereafter, Mayor Duncan invited Oakwood School representatives to provide an update on projects and issues. This update was provided by School Board President Todd Duwel, School Superintendent Kyle Ramey and Treasurer/Business Manager Kevin Philo. Following the school's presentation, Mayor Bill Duncan and City Manager Norbert Klopsch provided an update on Oakwood projects and issues. At the conclusion of the presentations, Mayor Duncan invited attendees to engage in a roundtable discussion. At 6:10 p.m., Mayor Duncan concluded the joint work session and thanked all for attending. School and library officials departed.

At 6:15 p.m., Mayor Duncan opened an executive session for personnel matters. All five Oakwood Councilmembers attended this executive session, as did City Manager Klopsch and Law Director Jacques. At 7:05 p.m., Mayor Duncan concluded the executive session for personnel matters and opened an executive session for conference with attorney. Councilmember Rob Stephens departed the meeting at this time. At 7:20 p.m., Mayor Duncan concluded the executive session for conference with attorney and adjourned the meeting.
